1. **Caste Certificate** issued by the Deputy Commissioner of the respective district.
2. **Income Certificate** from the Circle Officer – Annual family income must not exceed ₹2.5 lakhs.
3. **Bonafide Certificate** from the Head of Institution (available from the college office).
4. **Active Bank Account** linked with **Aadhaar**.
5. **Mobile number** linked with Aadhaar (Face Authentication via NSP OTR App is mandatory).

- After completing the online application, all students must **submit a hard copy of the application form along with all supporting documents to the College Office for verification on or before 30th September 2025.**
- Students failing to submit the documents in the college within the stipulated time will not be considered for verification.
